## The "Big 3"

In order to move forward in launching a Onevoice club, there are a 3 things you will need to have in place. Once these are complete, you will be ready to move onto a campus and begin reaching students for Jesus!

**Note:** Before working on a campus, your local Pastor and Church Leadership should fully support the vision of adopt-a-school. It is important that your club works in conjunction with the local body of Christ. Jesus clubs are Student Led and Church fed.

## **#1 BUILD A TEAM**

We want to emphasize the importance of a solid, committed leadership team. Each member should be like-minded and biblically founded in all that they do. Weekly attendance, regular student engagement, and frequent team prayer are vital for successful student ministry. Integrity and character - manifested through follow through and faithfulness - must be present for you to have a successful team.

An ideal team size is 3-5 people. These leaders will work together to address teaching, discipleship, prayer, and student hospitality. Look for willing adults within your church to build your team.

## **#2 FIND A STUDENT**

The best student leaders are passionate to see their friends saved and are hungry for personal spiritual growth. Campus clubs **must** be student led. You do not have access to a campus apart from a student. In no way should you or your team try to take over the Bible Club, but instead serve the dreams that are in the students' hearts, impart vision, and give leadership and guidance. Your team is there to equip the students and partner with them to reach their campus with the gospel.

## **Student Responsibilities:**

Students are responsible to build a student leadership team around the vision of reaching every student on their campus with the Good News.

### Core Actions

- a) Find a teacher sponsor
- b) Get the club approved by school faculty
- c) Secure a meeting location for weekly Jesus Club gatherings.
- d) Brainstorm creative ways to promote the bible club meetings, as well as the other activities that will be taking place.
- e) Live and love like Jesus on your campus

### **#3 FIND A TEACHER**

Find a Bible believing teacher who is willing to be the club advisor and can commit to being present at all Jesus Club meetings. If multiple meetings will be held, multiple advisors may be needed. While finding a teacher advisor is primarily the responsibility of student leaders, your adult leaders can assist by helping students connect with teachers in your church.

The ideal candidate for a teacher advisor will share your vision of seeing a campus reached for Jesus. It can be very difficult for your adult team and student leaders if the teacher advisor does not have a vision to reach students outside of their classroom. The student leader and your adult team should meet with any prospective teachers to discuss the vision for the club and confirm that the teacher is fully supportive. Arranging this meeting is the responsibility of the student; however, you are welcome to assist, if able.
